## Profile

The 234-room Pangu 7 Star Hotel is an opulent 21st-century modern hotel which is set to become a distinct and recognisable icon for new China. The hotel combines a prestigious location overlooking the 2008 Beijing Olympic Park, elegant East-meets-West design, auspicious feng shui detailing and unique services befitting its distinguished clientele of diplomats, senior executives and royalty.

## Location

27 Central North 4th Ring Road  
Chaoyang District, Beijing 100101, China

Stunningly situated beside the 2008 Beijing Olympic Park, Pangu 7 Star Hotel affords jaw-dropping views of the 'Bird's Nest' National Stadium and 'Water Cube' Aquatic Centre, which guests can access via the Ruyi bridge over Pangu Gardens. Beside the 4th Ring Road, the hotel also enjoys convenient access via new highways to Beijing Capital Airport and all the city's major attractions making it an ideal destination for leisure and business.

## Architecture

Pangu 7 Star Hotel is a part of Pangu Plaza, a five-tower complex comprising a 45-floor 5A office tower, luxury serviced apartments, stylish restaurants, a high-end shopping mall and 21-storey Pangu 7 Star Hotel.

Pangu Plaza was built by world-renowned, Taiwanese architect C.Y. Lee, architect of the 508-metre-tall Taipei 101, the second-tallest building in the world. The complex is designed in Lee's trademark Chinese postmodernist style and resembles the form of a Chinese dragon. The hotel is the pinnacle of Pangu Plaza.

## Accommodation

The hotel offers 234 guest rooms, including 140 suites. Ten room categories range in size from 45 to 488 sqm, and all have 3.5-metre ceilings.

## Signature Services and Facilities

All guests enjoy personalised butler service. The hotel offers TechnoGym fitness facilities and will offer a day spa and indoor pool. VVIP pick-up available direct from the airport with a private concierge in the hotel's luxurious GMC Savana four-seat van. Ruyi bridge access to the 2008 Beijing Olympic Park and the Olympic Stadiums.

## Events and Meetings

High-level meetings and events facilities are located on the third and fourth floors. There are also two columnless ballrooms: The Pangu Ballroom on the third floor is 738 sqm and can accommodate 400 people. The Grand Ballroom atop the Dragon Corridor on the fourth floor is 888 sqm, and can seat up to 500 people. It also has 15-metre-high ceilings, picture windows framing the iconic 2008 Olympic Stadiums, watercube, large pre-function areas and alfresco terrace space. The hotel also boasts five meeting rooms ranging in sizes from 68 to 176 sqm.

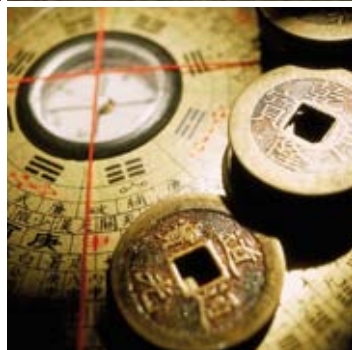
The Grand Ballroom and the Pangu Ballroom are equipped with:

## Design

The opulent but welcoming design by Ricardo Bello Dias strikes a masterful balance between Chinese classical tradition and contemporary European glamour. All marble throughout the building is imported from Italy, and often embellished with traditional Chinese motifs hand engraved by local craftsmen. Contemporary furnishings, lighting and technology are by the world's top brands, including: Lighting by Italian consultants Metis who work with Bvlgari hotels; Light fixtures by Venini from Italy; Baker Furniture, as featured in the American White House; Bose surround sound speaker systems; Deluxe 600 thread count Egyptian cotton bedding by Frette.

Solid granite dragon thrones and rosewood ceiling murals carved with scenes from the classic story 'A Dream of Red Mansions' adorn the lobby.

## Restaurants and Lounges

### Kaden Minokichi

300-year-old Japanese restaurant serving set kaiseki menus in six private tatami rooms. Seats 38. Set menus range from RMB 1,800–8,000 per person.

### Pangu Wenqi Chinese Restaurant

Across the fifth and sixth levels, 26 private dining suites. The menu highlights prestigious Cantonese and Chiu Chow cuisine. Seats 148.

### Auspicious Garden

All-day dining restaurant serving a delectable buffet spread of Asian and Western specialities. Seats 128.

### Karma Lounge

Situated adjacent to the lobby this residential style lounge is the ideal venue for high teas and evening aperitifs. Seats 68.



### Happiness Lounge

Arguably Beijing's most scenic drinking venue, the 21<sup>st</sup>-floor bar affords jaw-dropping views of the 2008 Olympic Stadiums by night. Seats 118.

## Feng Shui

Pangu Plaza and Pangu 7 Star Hotel have been fully designed according to ancient Chinese feng shui principles to bring prosperity and good fortune to their inhabitants. The building is defined as a 'yang' dragon. This is designed to complement the 'yin' of Dragon Lake in the adjacent National Forest Park.

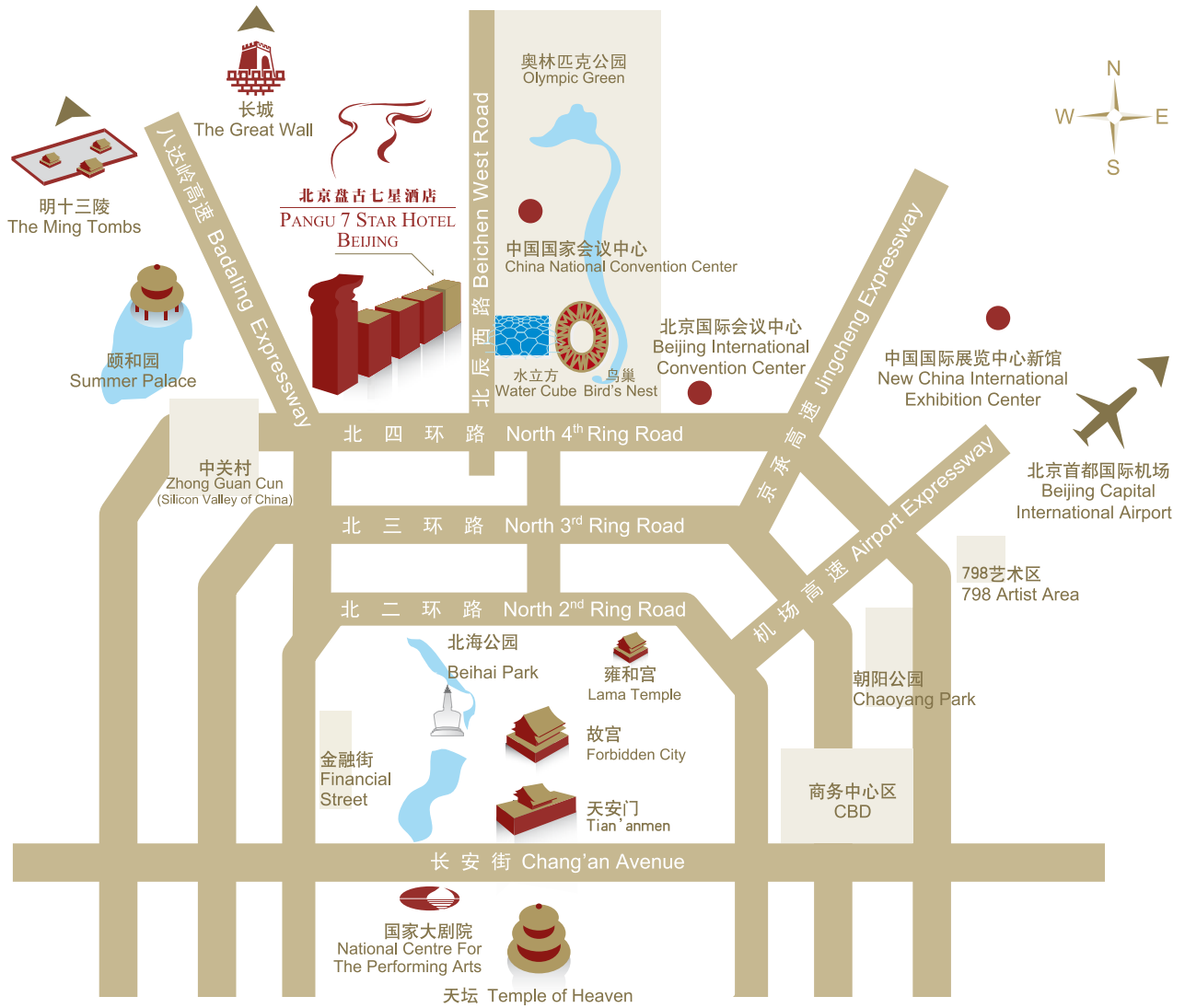
Pangu Plaza lies directly north of China's seat of government at Zhongnanhai and the new National Centre for the Performing Arts, a corridor known as the 'Dragon Vein'. The Dragon Vein forms a triangle with Financial Street in the west creating a pyramid of world economic and social development. The name Pangu references the creator of heaven and earth in Chinese mythology. The 7 Stars are an allusion to The Big Dipper or The Plough, the auspicious seven star constellation which has guided travellers since ancient times.

## Art Collection

Pangu 7 Star Hotel Beijing, is the only hotel to have been granted permission from the Palace Museum to reproduce priceless artworks from the Forbidden City. The masterworks were recreated on burnished copper panels in Italy.

## Olympic Park

Pangu Plaza is the only commercial building complex in the immediate vicinity of the 2008 Beijing Olympic Park. The Pangu 7 Star Hotel overlooks the Olympic facilities, dominated by the 'Bird's Nest' National Stadium and 'Water Cube' Aquatic Centre. It also offers sweeping green vistas of the 680 ha National Forest Park and the 122 ha Dragon Lake.
